
B-Body Brake Valve Sets What do you really need for your car?

The following guidelines are NOT absolutes. Some cars were built with last year's parts, or mid-year changes. The only way to know for sure is to look at the parts on your car.


67-70	All drum brake cars use only RBVOO1
71-74	All drum brake cars use only RBV006
67-78	All Disc Brake cars use RBV001 & RBV004
69	Early built cars with front disc should use RBV001 & RBV004 Late built cars with front disc should use RBV001, RBV003 & RBV004
70	Early built cars with front disc should use RBV001, RBV003 & RBV004 Late built cars with front disc should use RBV002 & RBV003
71	All Disc brake cars should use RBV005 & RBV007
72-74	All Disc brake cars should use RBV008 (Cast Iron)



























